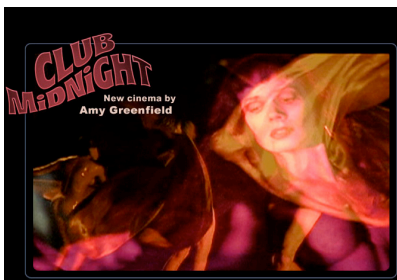




Katie Madonna Lee WOMEN'S PRISON
